The Dawson Regional Planning Commission (the Commission) was established in 2019 in accordance with Chapter 11 of the Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in Final Agreement (THFA). The Commission is an independent body consisting of six members, nominated by the Government of Yukon and Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in Government (the Parties).

Working with the Parties, and through public participation, the Commission's mandate is to develop a regional land use plan for Settlement Land and Non-Settlement Land within the Dawson planning region that is consistent with and achieves the objectives of Chapter 11 of the THFA. The Commission's Vision Statement, Draft Plan Goals, reports and other planning products are available on the Commission's website at [dawson.planyukon.ca](http://dawson.planyukon.ca).

The Project (#2020-0075) is located within the Dawson planning region. The Commission has reviewed this proposal and offers the following comments:

**The Commission has not yet developed land use and management recommendations for this area of the planning region, and as such, the Commission is not in a position at this time to advise if the proposal would be in conformity with the recommended land use plan.** However, the Commission recommends that the Dawson Designated Office consider that land use decisions on projects of this scope that are made prior to the completion of a land use plan may impact the Commission's ability to develop recommendations for the appropriate use of land, water, and other renewable and non-renewable resources within the planning region.
